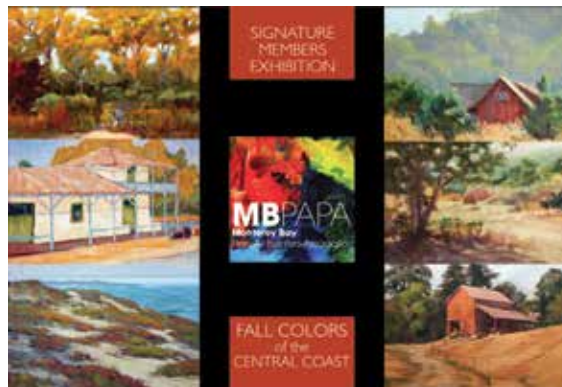

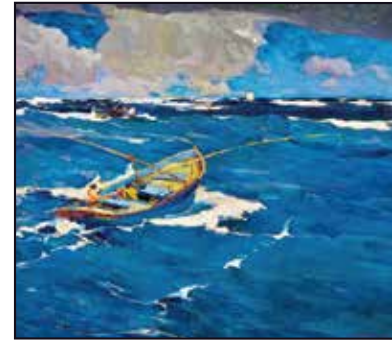
Monterey Museum of Art at La Mirada

begin in January. Plan to have fun together.

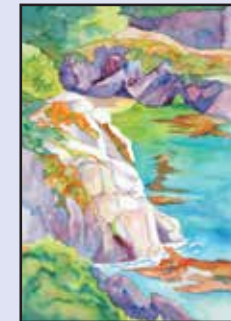
