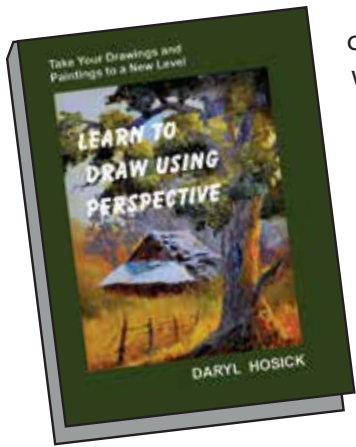

"I have noticed that many artists could significantly improve their work if they had a basic knowledge of how to use perspective in their work - particularly in plein air work where it is difficult to see just how perspective fits into the drawing process. I felt that I could really help if I wrote a book specifically for artists like us - not mystique and science - but instead how to better capture most of the subjects

we like to paint. I think many of us avoid complex man made subjects and I believe the information presented will really help. The judges voted the painting, "Tending Hay Bales" as the work of art that best captured the art competition theme of "Inspired Carmel Valley Impression." It also received First Place from the **Carmel Valley Art Association Board** of artist directors.

"I watch this field as it changes through the year as it is at the bottom of the hill from where I live. It represents a remnant of what life in Carmel Valley used to be before so many rushing cars and houses took over. There are a few more parcels of prime agricultural land left in the valley. Some are slated for development. Wouldn't it be wonderful if this prime land could be saved? That would aid in helping to preserve the rural quality and sustainability of Carmel Valley".

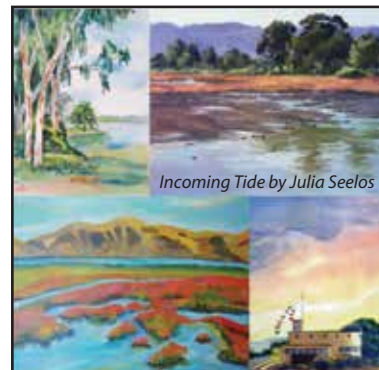


POPS IN THE BAYLANDS

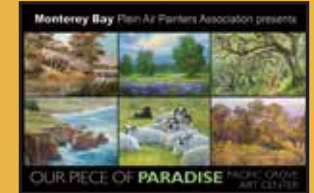

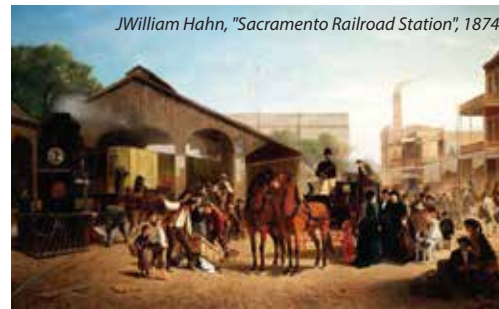
