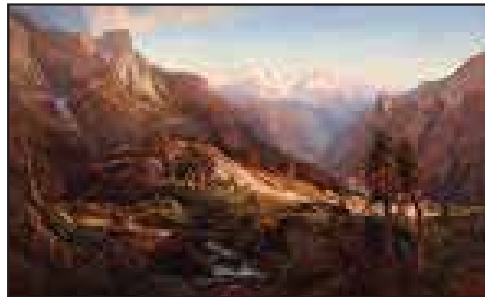

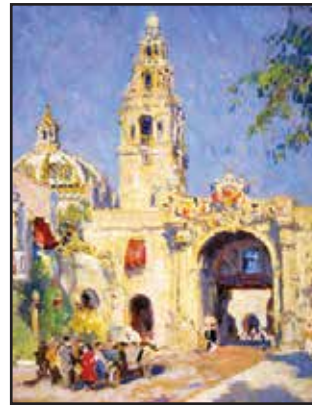

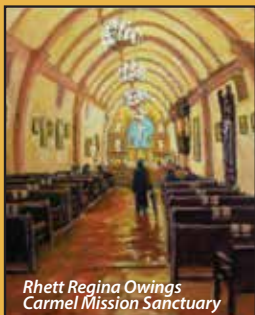


MICHELE HAUSMAN will participate in Valley of Hearts Delight at Filoli Historic Site: August 30 - October 23.



MICHELE will be exhibiting at the Kings Mountain Art Fair Labor Day weekend, on Skyline Boulevard in Woodside.

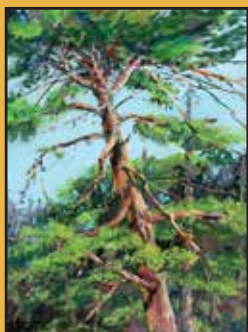

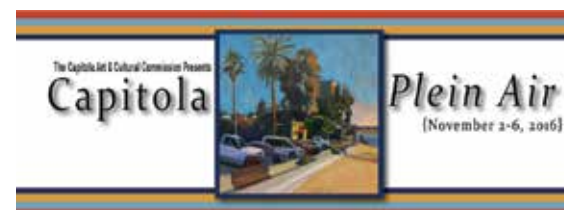
