GOLDEN BEAR PASS

MBPAPA members 62 years of age or older can qualify for a *Limited Use Golden Bear" pass for Point Lobos State Park. The pass is good from January 1st to December 31st (Calendar Year). At the cost of \$20.00 the pass can be used for a one passenger vehicle entry and parking where fees are collected at all State Parks. It is **NOT VALID from Friday** before Memorial Day thru **Labor Day**. Passes can be obtained at the California State Department of Parks & Recreation near the Monterey Airport at 2211 Garden Road. Also MBPAPA members might consider joining the **Point Lobos Foundation**. Artists can upload & share art work created at the park in the on-line gallery of the Point Lobos Foundation. 
This is a body of work that

24TH ANNUAL CARMEL ART FESTIVAL

The popular Carmel plein air festival happens again this May in Carmel.

Wednesday May 17th artists start painting after checking in. **Friday** May 19th 6-8pm artists hang their best two paintings on the displays on Mission



Street adjacent to Devendorf Park. The walls are well lit for early browsers. Judges select winners.

Saturday May 20th – 8am. Ribbons are placed on winning paintings by 10am and the festival opens to the public for bidding via silent auction. Meet the Artists 3:30 to 5pm. Following the silent auction there will be a live auction of paintings that received more than 10 bids. Award Ceremony at 5pm. **Sunday** May 21st new paintings are displayed replacing the sold works. **Quick Draw** painting 9-11am. Paintings will be displayed at Devendorf Park when completed. At noon there will be a 30-minute silent auction during which time the Quickdraw winner will be named. **Festival Closes at 3 pm.**
