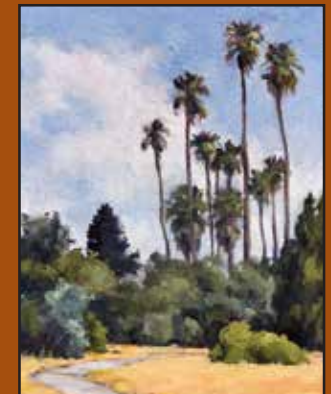
FRANK BETTE PAINT-OUT

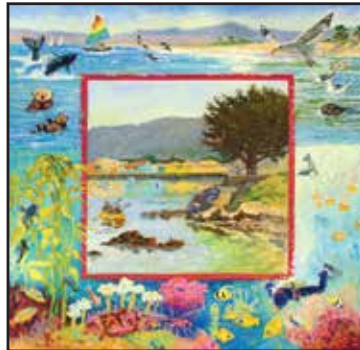

Collecting the Art of California at Gardena High School 1919-1956,

The 100th Anniversary Exhibit of the Gardena High School Art Collection will be open at the Hilbert Museum of California Art at Chapman University from through October 19th, 2019. This extraordinary exhibit will include nearly the entire collection of more than 70 of the paintings acquired between 1919 and 1956. Never before has this expansive collection been seen by the public. The Collection is widely acknowledged as one of the outstanding collections of **California Impressionism** in the country. What began in 1919 as a lesson in art appreciation for the high school's graduating class matured into an exceptional collection, an art association, and a cherished community tradition.

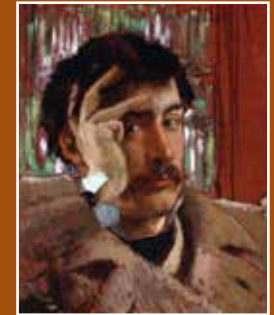
A TOAST TO THE COAST

The first major survey of the artist's career in over 20 years, this international retrospective will examine over 60 paintings, works on paper, and enamels. Tissot contributed to the academy and the avant-garde, participating in diverse venues such as the Paris Salon, London's Royal Academy and the Grosvenor and Dudley Galleries.
